- VISTA 2015 is the district's plan to increase measured achievement for every student by increasing the staff's ability to meet individual student learning needs.
- There are 56 schools in the district: 2 preschools, 27 elementary schools, 4 K-8 schools, 1 K-9 school, 6 middle schools, 1 academy for grades 6-12, 4 comprehensive high schools, 3 Pilot schools, 1 vocational/technical college, 1 gifted and talented K-8 school, and 6 charter schools.
- The current total enrollment for Aurora Public Schools is 36,967 students.
- Seventy-one cents of every dollar from the APS operating budget goes directly to support the instructional programs.
- Aurora Public Schools offers programs for gifted and talented students from elementary through high school.
- The International Baccalaureate program offers elementary, middle and high school students an academic challenge from a global perspective.
- Aurora Public Schools offers athletics and comprehensive arts activities for middle and high school students.
