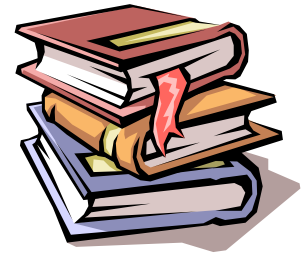


AURORA SCHOOLS FEDERAL CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Complete attached application—MUST be typed.
- Submit 2 letters of recommendation— at least one from a teacher,
- Submit an unofficial transcript from your Fall semester.
- Submit one (1) complete original application and five (5) complete collated and stapled copies. AEF must receive all six (6) packets by the deadline date and time for your application to be considered. Submit application materials to:
